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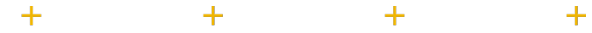

MISSION

TRIO Student Support Services at Oregon State University fosters an institutional climate supportive of the success of first-generation, Pell-eligible and students with documented disabilities. TRIO provides opportunities for academic growth and development throughout a student's college career. The program promotes progress through advocacy and services to assist with basic college requirements and serves to motivate students toward the successful completion of their post-secondary education and beyond their college career.

ELIGIBILITY

Students eligible for program services must meet at least **one** of the following criteria:

- First generation; meaning neither parents or guardians have a four-year college degree
- Students that meet income guidelines (such as qualifying for the Federal Pell Grant)
- Have a documented disability
